SUBJECT: Permanent interment in France.

1. In reply to your letter of September 10, 1920, you are advised that instructions will be issued that the remains of your husband, the late 1st Lieutenant J. D. Arnett, be permanently interred in Belgium under the conditions outlined in letter from this office dated August 31, 1920.

2. If it becomes necessary to transfer the remains of this officer from grave #51, plot #32, row "D", Lijssenthock British Military Cemetery, Poperinghe, West Flanders, Belgium, to a permanent American field of honor you will be duly advised of the new grave location.

3. This office assures you that the grave of your husband will always be fittingly and tenderly maintained by the Government.
