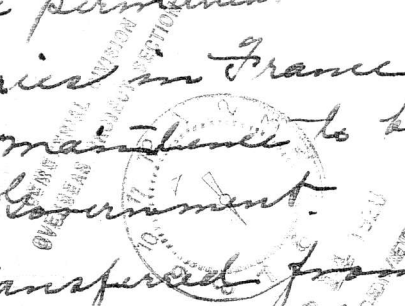

I am simply grieved to know that it is necessary for the body of my husband to be again reinterred.

But since it has become a necessity I advise that his body be moved to one of the three permanent American Cemeteries in France and its future maintenance to be the care of our Government.

It was first transferred from Mont Des Cats. so I ask you kindly to have my husbands body

I ask also that
you be sure to notify me when the

Cemetery, location from Paris, No
of row, No of Grave ect. for I expect
to visit France and shall want
the complete location of grave, also
a picture of the grave. I shall desire
to be notified when the stone
marker is erected.

handed with care.
