I was called to administer first aid to Pvt. Carl E. Bird at about 2:30 P. M. Sept. 26, 1918. No wound was visible, but blood was flowing from nose and mouth. His limbs were paralyzed. He was removed to first aid station where physician pronounced it to be a fracture of the base of the skull. He died about 9:30 P. M. Sept. 26th, 1918. He was buried on battle field near Ivory, France on Sept 27, 1918.
