Unconfirmed grave location.

1. In reply to your letter of November 25th 1921, you are advised that the investigation instituted by this office to determine the grave location of your son, the late Private Warren D. Charles, Company G, 7th Infantry, has so far been without success. While it is impossible to state definitely whether or not the grave of this soldier will ever be located, this office assures you that every effort will be made to do so, and that the length of time that will elapse while the investigation is conducted does not necessarily indicate that it may not finally be successful.

2. You are assured that as soon as the grave location of the deceased is determined, you will be immediately advised and instructions will be issued that his body be returned to this country for final burial.

3. You are further advised that the work of returning the remains of our soldier dead has not as yet been completed. It is stated, however, that this work is being prosecuted as vigorously as conditions and accurate and reverent handling of our soldier dead will permit.
