Request letter to Mr. and Mrs. B.J. Charles- Leck Box 626, Arcade, N.Y. as follows:

1..... We are please th inform them that the search for the remains of their son Private Warren D. Charles- 542000, Company G, 7th Infantry, who so nobly gave his life October 11, 1925 for the cause for which he was fighting, has be recovered from an iselated grave in the Commue of Cierges, Dept of Meuse, and is being held in the Mortuary of the Meuse-Argonne American Cemetery # 1232, Romagne-sous-Montfaucen, Dept. of Meuse, awaiting final disposition advice as our records show request for the return of the body to yau, therefore it is the desire of this office to know if this is still your wich --- etc.

266/Tag was found on the remains-- which read "WARREN D. CHARLES- Co. G, 7th Inf. on reverse side was "542000"; this tag was placed with body. Also was found on reamins a wrist watch which is being forwarded to the Claims section of the General Accounting Office- Washington, D.C. with request that same be forwarded to you. This watch was found broken.
