Killed in action on the afternoon of Sept. 28th 1918 at Duncan Post, Hindenburg Line. Buried at St Emille, France in the American Plot, Row I Grave 6. Cpl. HYDE was corporal of my squad, we had left the jumping off place and were going straight ahead. We had only gone about 30 or 40 yds. when Cpl. Hyde plunged forward and fell in a heap on the ground. He gave a sharp cry after stretching out on the ground and by the time I had caught up to him he was dead. He must have been hit by a good many bullets because there were numerous wounds bleeding all over his chest and stomach. Death was quick and I think he never knew what ~~xxx~~ struck him.
