With reference to your letter of September 2nd, I have the honor to advise you that the records of this office show that Private Ralph R. Johncox, Co. A, 106th Infantry #1,213,480, was reported by the Commanding General, American Expeditionary Forces as ~~being~~ ^{having} died September 29th, 1918, of wounds received in action while a member of the American Expeditionary Forces. At present no information is available as to place of death.

The fact that your letter was not addressed to the bureau to which the matter inquired about pertained, accounts for the delay, as the same was not received in this office until yesterday.
