“BOYS OF BATTERY D” 307TH FIELD ARTILLERY

AND THE OTHER MEMBERS OF WYOMING COUNTY’S FIRST TWO CONTINGENTS OF WWI DRAFTEES

Men listed in bold are most likely to be in the Battery D photo. Their names appear on the official “Initial Muster Roll of Battery ‘D’ of the 307th Field Artillery from Dates of Enlistment (September 1917) to October 31, 1917.”

Men not in bold aren’t listed on Battery D’s Initial Muster Roll but were also members of the county’s first two draft contingents. A few may have been temporarily assigned to the battery at the time of the photo. About 45 of the second Wyoming County contingent of 93 men were sent to a Depot Brigade rather than to Battery D and from there received assignments to other units.
