INSTRUCTIONS.

1. When preparing report, obtain the correct spelling of all names to be entered.

2. Write the name of the organization in full.

3. Casualties and changes not reported on date of occurrence will be reported on subsequent reports specifying date of occurrence.

4. The names of commissioned officers to be listed by grade and to precede names of soldiers which will be listed alphabetically in each company. Soldier's number to immediately follow surname.

The following information is required, in the order indicated:

(A) DIED OR KILLED—Cause of death. State whether line of duty or not line of duty, and whether or not result of own misconduct; place, date, and time of death.

(B) MISSING—(Except deserted (D) and A. W. O. L. (H)). Give date.

(C) WOUNDED AND SICK—State whether wounded in action; otherwise if wounded or sick, whether line of duty or not line of duty, and whether or not result of own misconduct. Special attention to be noted that men "Sick in Quarters" not to be included on this report. Wounded to be classified as serious or slight. If sent to hospital, indicate if possible, name of latter.

(D) DETACHED SERVICE—Give location, origin or order and date.

(E) TRANSFERS—Give specific unit to which transferred, origin of order and date. It is absolutely necessary that name of organization, also company, if any, from which received, be entered in full.

(G) DISCHARGED—Nature of cause for, and authority. A. W. O. L.—Give date, and hour, if possible.

(H) DESERTED—Give all information available.

(I) CONFINEMENT—Give authority, particulars as to extent of.

(K) COURT-MARTIALS—Specify "General," "Special" or "Summary;" date approved and Article of War; sentence or acquittal.

(L) PROMOTIONS AND DEMOTIONS—Give authority and date of same, stating grade.

(M) FURLONGHS AND LEAVES—Give authority for, time furlough or leave is to begin, and, when possible, place to be visited.

(N) MEDALS—Give date awarded and reason for award.

(O) DROPPED FROM ROLLS—(Except A-E-6-1) Reason and date.

(P) A change of person to be notified in emergency, or change of address of person to be notified must also be entered.

(Q) The total of officers and soldiers present and absent is to be entered in space provided; all officers and soldiers to be considered present unless absent sick, absent in confinement, absent detached, absent special duty, on leave or furlough and missing.

(R) Unable to perform duty through the intemperate use of drugs or alcoholic liquor or through disease or injury the result of his own misconduct.

5. Any other information of vital or informative value respecting individuals should be given, the particular fact written out.

6. Three copies of this report to be forwarded daily to the Statistical Section, Division Headquarters, two copies of which are then to be forwarded to the STATISTICAL DIVISION, A. G. O., A. E. F.

CAUTIONS.

When recording transfers to hospitals, state definitely whether man is transferred for duty or treatment. In case of enlisted men, specify "transferred to hospital" or "transferred to hospital."
