1. Upon investigation, it has been ascertained that the date of death of the above man heretofore communicated to you, is erroneous, and that Private 1st-class Glen C. Sprague, #1,213,589, Company A, 108th Infantry, was killed in action October 17, 1918. ✓

2. For purposes of identification, you are advised that the records show that the deceased was enlisted July 30, 1917, and the name of the person to be notified in case of emergency was given as: Mrs. Anna J. Sprague, West Batavia, N. Y. ✓
