During the course of our investigation to locate the grave of Private 1/cl Charles Votrie, it was discovered that an Unknown American Soldier, reported as either Private 1/cl Charles Votrie or Private Robert Campbell, was reburied in Grave #53, Section A, Plot #2, American Cemetery #617, Fismes, (Marne). However, this body could not be identified as being that of either Private 1/cl Votrie or Private Campbell.

3. For your information there is enclosed herewith copy of our report covering disinterment and reburial of this Unknown Soldier and it is requested that you advise this office whether or not you recall burying a soldier, who was killed by a machine gun bullet as stated on Form 16-A and who wore a medal ribbon as described thereon.
