 59th Inf., also "U.S." A medal ribbon was
 found with three stripes; center stripe red;
 two outer stripes yellow. Two ribs were
 found left side grown together. "

Records of France show that the
 above is either Charles Votrie, or Robert
 Campbell, both of Co. B, 59th Inf., but the
 dental chart does not check with either man.
