Private Walter D. White, (Deceased), Co. B, 309th Inf.

For extraordinary heroism in action near the Bois des Loges, France, 1 Nov. '18.

While acting as runner, Private White volunteered to carry a message across a long stretch of open country which was subjected to heavy machine gun and artillery fire. He successfully crossed the space and delivered his message, but in an attempt to return, he was killed by a rain of machine gun bullets. His conduct served as an inspiration to other runners.
