## MEMORANDUM

Subject: Request for ~~final record~~ in the case of Private Walter D. White, #1, 750,790, Company B, 309th Infantry.

The above named soldier was reported by the Commanding General, AEF, in Casualty Cablegram 327 as died November 9, 1918, from wounds received in action. Inventory of Effects on file in this office shows this soldier to have died November 9, 1918. In the 2nd Indorsement of his Service Record it is stated that this soldier was killed in action November 1, 1918. A Medical Card on file in this office shows this soldier to have died November 9, 1918, at 4:30 A.M. at Evacuation Hospital #11, from a gunshot wound in right side of head.
